Faithful Citizenship.

In November of this year, Virginia will hold a state election to elect/reelect all 100 members of the State House of Delegates and all 40 members of the State Senate. In November 2015 the US Conference of Catholic Bishops approved and published the document *Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship* to help Catholics form their consciences in accordance with the truth, so they could make good moral choices. The bishops do not tell Catholics how to vote, that responsibility rests with each person and his or her properly formed conscience. A summary of the bishop's document is posted in the narthex.

Future Morals in Virginia.

During the 2019 legislative session, the State of Virginia came very close to becoming one of the states approving the extreme laws that would legalize abortion up to the immediate time of birth. There were also significant inroads made on legislation which would legalize euthanasia. Continuing to defeat such legislation is critical to maintaining the moral standards we espouse as Catholics. It is therefore very important that we elect legislatures who also support the morals and beliefs that we hold, the alternative would be devastating.
