FREE Screening of *Unprotected* February 23 at St. Pius X:

For over 50 years, Margaret Sanger led a battle for unrestricted and widespread use of contraception. She promised that it would result in happiness, freedom, and fulfillment. Her opposition came primarily from one source: The Catholic Church. St. Pope Paul VI, in his 1968 encyclical, *Humanae Vitae (On Human Life)*, argued that contraception would lead only to enslavement, abuse, and heartache. Who was right? Come watch *Unprotected*, a new film by Donald J. Thompson and join the discussion afterwards. The film will be shown in Memorial Hall, behind St. Pius X Catholic School, 7800 Halprin Drive in Norfolk, at 6:30 PM.
