## **All Souls Day Novena**

Envelopes are available in the narthex for inscribing the names of your departed loved ones. The envelopes will be placed next to the tabernacle during the novena (Nov. 1-8) so the people listed will be especially remembered at all Holy Masses. It is a sacred tradition, nay, obligation, to pray for the dead.
